"... that the Vice-Chancellor shall not reject the representation on the only ground that the candidate will not be in a position to make up the attendance in the academic year since there is a provision under Ordinance 6.2 for condonation of shortage of lectures upto 10% in theory and practical and the further requirement that the candidate shall not in any case fall short of 60% attendance."

Accordingly you are, therefore, requested to admit the students in the first instance, if otherwise eligible as per Ordinance of H.P. University and directed to ensure the 60% attendance admitted students according to above order and send their cases later on in a consolidated manner to this office so that the ex-post-facto approval of the Vice-Chancellor is obtained.
